



REGULATIONS COMPETITION I CANARIAS OPEN MASTER – INTERNATIONAL TROPHY ARTISTIC SWIMMING BRILLIANCE IN PARADISE

1. DATE

18–19 April 2026

2. VENUE – POOL

Las Palmas de Gran Canaria – Club Natación Metropole

3. PARTICIPATION

3.1. Eligible participants are athletes from clubs affiliated with the **Canary Islands Swimming Federation**, as well as clubs from other national or international federations affiliated with **AQUA**, provided they hold a valid licence for the master category and the artistic swimming discipline.

3.2. The minimum age for participation is 25 years. However, the organisation allows athletes between 20 and 24 years of age to participate, provided the team's average age is 25 years.

4. AGE GROUPS

4.1. Three Age Groups will be established in accordance with the **General Masters Provisions** (MA_G_01 – General Masters Provisions) for the Combined Routine:

- **Group I:** 25–39
- **Group II:** 40–64
- **Group III:** 65+

4.2. In free duet, trio, free team and combined routine, the group will be determined by the average age of the competitors, calculated as of 31 December 2026.

5. COMPETITION

5.1. Events: Free Solo, free duet, trio, free team and combined routine.

5.2. No gender restrictions will apply in any event.

5.3. Each swimmer may participate in a maximum of 4 routines (Free Solo, free duet, trio, free team and combined routine).

5.4. Participation is possible in all three Age Groups described in 4.1.

5.5. Routine duration: no minimum, but the following maximums:

- Free duet: 2 min 45 s





- Trio: 2 min 45 s
- Free team: 3 min 30 s
- Combined routine: 4 min
- Free Solo: 2min 15 s

5.5.1. **Brilliance in Paradise Team:** to give all athletes the opportunity to experience swimming in a team, the Canarias Open offers the possibility to participate in a mixed team with athletes from different clubs and nationalities. To take part, this must be indicated during registration. The organisation will provide a video for routine learning.

5.6. The Jury will consist of 2 panels (3 to 5 judges each):

- **Panel 1: Technical Merit** – evaluates execution, synchronisation and difficulty.
- **Panel 2: Artistic Impression** – evaluates choreography, musicality and presentation.

Scores will range from 0 to 10 points (with increments of 0.10).

6. COMPETITION PROGRAMME

6.1. The competition will be held in 2 sessions:

- Saturday morning session: Free Solo, Trio, and Free Team
- Sunday morning session: Free Duet and Combination Routine

7. COMPETITION FORMAT

7.1. The competition will be held as direct finals (no qualifying rounds).

8. DRAW & AWARDS

8.1. For each event, a draw will be held at the FCN 48–72 hours before the start to determine the start order.

8.2. Medals will be awarded to the top three in each age group and event (duet, trio, team, combined routine).

8.3. **Anna Tarrés Award:** This prize will be awarded to the most creative routine in the Combination Routine event.

9. REGISTRATION

9.1. **Mandatory pre-registration.** As this is the first edition, all national and international teams must pre-register via the official website www.brillianceinparadise.es to secure their place. The pre-registration form will also ask whether your club can provide judges and/or volunteers for the competition and in which events they could officiate.

Pre-registration is free and will be available from 10 October to 28 November 2025.

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9.1.1. Each club may register one Free Solo, with the possibility of entering a second one, provided that the club also registers in at least one of the other events: Duet, Trio, Team, or Combination Routine.

9.2. **Registration.** From 1 December 2025 to 27 February 2026.

9.3. The registration process will be carried out through the official website www.brillianceinparadise.es

9.4. Provisional and final participant lists, along with publication dates, will be available on the website www.brillianceinparadise.es

9.5. The registration fee is **40 euros per person** (regardless of the number of events entered). Payment must be made by bank transfer before 26 February to the following account:

9.6. Once registration is completed, withdrawals will not entitle participants to a refund of fees.

9.7. **Music submission.** Deadline: 3 April 2026 at 23:59. Files must be sent in MP3 or WAV format to musica@fedecanat.es labelled as follows: Age Group–Routine–Club–Athlete's Name.
